Mr. Pierre Richard Coupet, age 69, passed away Saturday, July 12, 2025 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center following a brief onset illness.

Born in 1956 in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, he was the son of the late Paul and Paula Coupet. Pierre immigrated to the United States as a young boy and was proud to refer to himself as an American. He served his country faithfully for twenty (20) years in the United States Armed Forces and was in the Persian Gulf War. After his discharge, he worked as a computer systems engineer and was in high demand until his health began to fail.

Aside from work, Pierre and Genevieve loved to travel and took many trips to support their grandchildren in recitals and family celebrations. They also enjoyed cruises and eating good meals with family and friends. Pierre had a love of cars and recently bought one of his dream cars, a vintage convertible.

Above all these things, though, Pierre was a man of compassion and heart. He would often stop to talk with people who seemed to be in need and say, "Tell me your story", and after hearing it, offer them assistance in some way ... never judging.

Pierre is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Genevieve; his daughters, Pasha and her husband Philip and Joanne and her husband Joshua; his grandchildren, and his brother, Philippe.

A Mass of Christian Burial, officiated by Father Bonafice Maasoayele, will be held at 11:00AM Wednesday, July 30, 2025 at St. Michael Catholic Church in Murrells Inlet. Military honors will be performed after the service. Inurnment will follow at a later date in New York.
