



## Poey Reynolds

January 15, 1938 - September 17, 2012

Conway...Poey Montgomery Reynolds, age 74, died Monday, September 17, 2012 at his residence.

Mr. Reynolds was born in Conway, a son of the late Perdie Montgomery Reynolds and Henrietta Jones Reynolds. He was the retired owner of Reynolds Construction after 42 years. Mr. Reynolds kept busy up until the past 1 1/2 years when his health wouldn't allow him to work or get out any longer. He was a loving husband, father and friend. Mr. Reynolds worked hard all of his life to ensure he had the best for his family. He always wanted more for his children than what he had growing up. If the family needed anything, he would say, "I'll just work another day". Mr. Reynolds loved life, always took his family camping, boating, and water skiing. He enjoyed having a good pig picking and relaxing on the river. As a father he always made sure while the kids were growing up that they went to church every Sunday. Even when the family went out of town he would take them to the nearest Baptist church or read the Sunday School lesson that Sunday morning. Mr. Reynolds was saved as a child and rededicated his life to God back in November. He was the best father anyone could ask for. Mr. Reynolds held the children to high standards. He made sure the family got what they needed and that they never went lacking. Mr. Reynolds was a good provider. When his son died at the early age of 18, part of him died that day. It took several years to recover. He was not one at that time to express his feelings in words. After that time he always made sure he said how he felt. Mr. Reynolds would always take the

boys on the job when they were young and taught them how to build things, work on cars, lawn mowers, and be able to fix anything around the house. There wasn't much our dad couldn't do. He was quite but when he spoke you knew what he meant. Mr. Reynolds was always very loving. He would always come home and take mom with him where ever he went. She would always go visit him on the job. Through the years he enjoyed dancing with his wife and being with friends. Mr. Reynolds felt family was very important and made sure we always had the family close and celebrated special occasions. He never had any enemies and made everyone feel welcome. Mr. Reynolds will be missed dearly by his family and friends. He was preceded in death by a son, Poey M. Reynolds, Jr.; two brothers, H.C. Reynolds and Robert "Bob" Reynolds; and two sisters, Earlene R. Lundy and Della Mae Reynolds. Surviving are his wife, Patricia S. Reynolds of Conway; three sons, Patrick C. Reynolds, Phillip S. Reynolds and Perry P. Reynolds all of Conway; one daughter, Pamela R. Davis (Samuel) of Conway; six grandchildren, Patrick C. Reynolds, Jr., Phillip S. Reynolds, II, Whitnee Reynolds, Magan Reynolds, Briana Davis, and Samuel Davis II; one great granddaughter, Alexis Reynolds Abbott.

Funeral services will be held 2:00 PM Friday at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel with Rev. Ray Lundy and Rev. Bill Harrill officiating. Burial will follow in Hillcrest Cemetery.
