R. Randall Anderson, age 81, husband of 52 years to Linda McIntyre Anderson, met his Lord and Savior Monday, February 13, 2017.

Mr. Anderson was born in Loris, SC, a son of the late Rev. John Robert "Bob" Anderson and Elizabeth Rhodes Anderson.

He was a US Air Force Veteran during the Korean War. Mr. Anderson worked as an electronic engineer during the Apollo Space Program in Cape Canaveral, FL and later with the Polaris Missile Program at the Charleston Shipyard. He then moved to Conway where he opened Anderson TV and Appliance. He also owned The Corral Arcade in Conway. Most recently he worked as a commercial real estate developer on local projects including Wild Wing Plantation.

Surviving in addition to his wife of Conway are his three children, Randy Anderson (Shannon Allen), Debbie Anderson Tilma (Tim) and Stephen M. Anderson (Martha Hucks) all of Conway; his seven grandchildren, Robbie, Rebekah and Sarah Anderson, Caroline Tilma Nagel (Brendan), Mary Kathryn Tilma, Mallory and Luke Anderson; one sister, Patricia Anderson Ingram of Marion, SC.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, James Alfred Anderson and John Franklin Anderson.
