Conway--Della Rae Woodle Daniels, wife of the Rev. Reverend Joseph C. Daniels, died Tuesday morning, October 27, 2009 at her home in Conway, SC. Rae was born in Conway to John D. and Beulah Woodle on November 23, 1929. She attended Mars Hill College, where she met her husband in 1946. They married in Conway in 1947. Rae received Bachelor's and Master's degrees from UNC Charlotte in 1967 and 1978, respectively. She taught English at Asheboro High School in Asheboro, NC, and at Crest High School in Shelby, NC. Rae and her husband retired in 1990 to her family homeplace in Conway. For the past sixteen years, Rae and Joe have represented the Western North Carolina Conference of the United Methodist Church as Volunteers in Mission (VIM) to Indonesia. As VIMs, Rae taught English, Joe served as minister to the congregation of Wesley Methodist Church in Medan, and together they assisted in building schools, churches, and wells on the island of Nias. Rae is survived by her husband of 62 years, and three children: Della Daniels Raines (Larry), their children, Greg (Jennifer) and grandson Austin, and Chris (Jessica); Joseph "Jody" Charles Daniels, Jr. (Monica) and their children, Christie and Leanne and granddaughter Adrianna; Janet Daniels Ray (Al) and her children John (Ashlee) and Jane Case; two sisters and one brother, and numerous nieces and nephews and their families. A memorial service celebrating the life of Rae will be held at First United Methodist Church, Conway, on Thursday, October 29 at 11:00 AM. The family will receive friends after the service in the fellowship hall of the church. In lieu
