He is survived by his wife of forty years, Treva Riggs of Conway; three daughters, Robin Riggs of Myrtle Beach, Shelley Riggs of Conway and Margaret Riggs of Harkers Island, NC; one son, John Riggs and his wife, Tammy of Smyrna, NC; three grandchildren, Jason Riggs and his wife, Star, Dalton Riggs and Rebecca Riggs; one great-granddaughter, Savannah Riggs.
