Conway... Ray Gene Boyd, age 71, passed away on Monday, February 15, 2021.

Ray was born June 21, 1949 in Conway, SC to loving parents of the late Vernon Jesse Boyd and the late Florine Watts Boyd Tadych. He attended Conway High School before choosing to enlist in the army. He served his country honorably and served one tour during the Vietnam War. After the war, Ray learned the trade of plumbing and was owner of Boyd's Plumbing until he retired in 2005.
