Murrells Inlet Raymond Francis Wrobleski, age 75 died Wednesday, June 28, 2006 at his home. Born January 17, 1931 in New York City, NY, he was the son of the late Stanley Adam and Helen Bertha Dawickowska Wrobleski. Mr. Wrobleski was a US Navy veteran. He had retired after 26 years of service from Grumman Aerospace, Bethpage, Long Island, NY. Mr. Wrobleski served Grumman as an aerospace machinist contributing to major projects which included the Lunar Module program which sent the first American astronauts to the Moon and returned them safely to Earth; as well as the first successful flight of the Navy's F14 Tomcat. He was preceded by a daughter, Pamela. Surviving are his wife of 51 years, Marilyn Wrobleski; son, Mark R. Wrobleski of Bayport, NY; daughters, Cynthia J. Marotta and Joanne Weimer both of Murrells Inlet and Jennifer L. Rivera of New Port Richey, FL and ten grandchildren. Memorial services will be 10:00 AM, Saturday at Goldfinch Funeral Home Beach Chapel. Inurnment will follow in Belin Memorial Methodist Cemetery.
