Myrtle Beach Rev. Ernest H. Chambers, Sr. Rev. Ernest H. Chambers, Sr., 81 of Myrtle Beach died Sunday, November 9, 2008 at his home. Born in Pickens County, SC, he was the son of the late Fred and Ruth Chambers. Rev. Chambers was a US Navy veteran serving from 1945 until 1953 in both World War II and the Korean Conflict. He was a graduate of Anderson High School in Anderson, SC and a graduate of Holmes Bible College in Greenville, SC. For the past 55 years, he had pastored several churches in South Carolina. He also had been President of the Grand Strand Ministerial Association and was Chaplain Coordinator for Ocean View Memorial Hospital. His first wife of 53 years, Ruby Griggs Chambers and a daughter, Sandra Lynn Herring, preceded him in death. Surviving are his wife, Muriel A. Chambers; sons, Ernest H. Chambers, Jr. and wife Edna of Myrtle Beach and Bill Atkins and wife Celeste of Spartanburg, SC; daughters, Patricia Rogers and husband Barry of Myrtle Beach, Debra Gross and husband Ron of Coeur d'Alene, ID, Donna Greer and husband Terry of Hartwell, GA, Elizabeth Atkins of Cincinnati, OH and Mary Madison and husband Brad of Charton Heights, WV; 16 grandchildren; 11 great grandchildren and one grandchild expecting.
