Richard Rubin Freed age 76, passed away Tuesday, July 10, 2012 at Tidelands Community Hospice House.

Born in Norwich, NY, he was a son of the late Daniel and Martha Freed. Richard was a U.S. Army veteran from 1954-1957 and was in the Presidential Honor Guard in Washington, DC. He graduated from the State University of New York at Brockport where he met his wife Carol of 54 year. He was chosen to be recognized in Who's Who of America. In 1960 Richard was granted a teaching assistantship and graduated in 1961 with a Masters Degree. From 1962-67 he taught Science for six years and in 1967 became the School Administrator in Webster, NY. In 1992 he was awarded the Citizen of the Year for serving his school and the community. After retiring in 1992, Richard and Carol moved to Salisbury, NC and then in 1999 they moved to Pawleys Island. He was an avid tennis player and was a member of the Litchfield Tennis Club where he enjoyed tennis with his many beloved friends. Tennis was an important part of his life for 59 years.

Survivors include his wife, Carol Freed of Pawleys Island; a daughter, Lorie

Reilly; a son, Darryl Freed and his grandchildren that Richard loved Maeve and Liam Reilly and Brittany Freed.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, July 24, 2012 at Pawleys Island Community Church with Reverend Don Williams officiating.
