All of sudden the boat started rocking and we heard a big splash. We both turned around and no Kelly. We immediately looked at each other and asked "Can he swim!" It took what seemed several minutes but up came Kelly with rod in his right hand, cigarette still in mouth, and his flat white hat still on his head, and him dog paddling in high gear. We laughed so hard we could hardly bring him back into the boat. Later we all laughed.

Kelly is compassionate, loving, and a hard nosed horse shoe player. A friend you will always remember. God bless you. I will miss you ole friend.
