



Richard Leavitt, Jr.

March 6, 1936 - February 20, 2014

Myrtle Beach...CDR Richard Campbell Leavitt, Jr., USN(Ret.), age 77, of Southern Trail, died Thursday, February 20, 2014 at Conway Medical Center after a long illness.

CDR. Leavitt was born in Syracuse, NY, a son of the late Richard Campbell and Eleanor Brigham Leavitt. He grew up in Port Chester, NY and completed his high school education at Wooster School in Danbury, CT. CDR. Leavitt graduated from Amherst College in 1957 with a Degree in History. In 1959, he entered OCS and was commissioned in the USN in 1959. He served on four ships during his 22 year career. CDR. Leavitt was Commanding Officer of the US Naval Facility in Bermuda and retired in 1981 in Washington, DC. He served one year in Vietnam and was awarded the Navy Commendation Medal and the Bronze star.

Surviving are his wife of 47 years, Vivian Kennedy Leavitt, one daughter, Victoria Anne Leavitt of Alexandria, VA, two brothers, Avery T. Leavitt of and Russell Leavitt of Brentwood, CO, and one sister, Susie Leavitt of Gig Harbor, WA. He is predeceased by a sister Bonnie Jean Smith.

His dog Lucy was a very special part of his life.

Memorial services will be held at 2:00 PM Tuesday at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel with Pastor John Kassouf officiating. Burial will follow in Arlington National Cemetery at a later date.

The family will receive friends from 1:00 PM until 2:00 PM Tuesday at the funeral home.

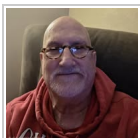

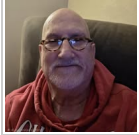
