Richard Jacob Loskill, Sr. entered into eternal rest on November 22, 2019. He was born October 21, 1945 in Hazleton, PA, to the late Eugene J. and Elizabeth Collette (Arey) Loskill.

After graduating from Hazleton High School, he served in the United States Coast Guard for four years, much of the time aboard the USCGC Bramble (WLB-392) as an Electrician's Mate. After his military service, he was graduated from the Pennsylvania State University, earning a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice. He enjoyed expanding his knowledge by reading about a multitude of subjects, especially history. He was an avid fan of the Nittany Lions football team.

After enjoying a long career in the probation and parole field, he retired as the Agent-in-Charge of the Georgetown County office of the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole, and Pardon services.

A lifelong Catholic, and longtime parishioner of Saint Michael's Catholic Church in Garden City Beach, South Carolina, he was involved with perpetual adoration and a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 8980. He was an enthusiast of Studebaker automobiles, and owned many different models. He enjoyed playing golf.
