FORMER MYRTLE BEACH MOTEL OWNER/MANAGER DIED SUNDAY,
JUNE 24, 2012 AT HIS RESIDENCE AFTER A LONG ILLNESS.

Born in Lawrence, MA, he was a son of the late Howard and Irene Wynock. Dick moved to East Providence, RI as a boy where he attended LaSalle Academy and East Providence High School. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War for 5 years as a Hospital Corpsman. He graduated from Boston University with a degree in Chemistry he also graduated from West Virginia University with a degree in Chemical Engineering. After graduating from Boston University he was transferred to West Virginia where he worked for several instrument companies selling and engineering chemical process equipment to the chemical industry. He established VECO, his own engineering company in the late 1960's. Dick was licensed to sell real estate in West Virginia and South Carolina and was a real estate investor. He was best known as owner of the Ocean Plaza Motel, South Ocean Blvd. He and Peggy retired from the Ocean Park and were former owners of the Twilight Surf Motel. He was a former member of Myrtle Beach Area Chamber of Commerce, Hotel Motel Association, U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, R.R.O.C. and ISA. Dick's religious preference was Baptist
