Riley Bloch, age 17, a Junior at Carolina Forest High School and Palm Academy, passed away Wednesday, February 25, 2015 at Waccamaw Community Hospital after injuries sustained from a car accident.

Riley was born in Myrtle Beach, SC, a son of Jon and Angie Bloch.

In addition to his parents, he leaves behind four sisters and two brother-in-laws; Mandy and Mark Ammons, Kim Mishoe, Meagan and Brad Parnell, Racheal Mishoe; two nephews, Trent Ammons and J.P. Parnell; one niece, Sarah Parnell; and two pending family additions, David and Baby Keyes.

Riley was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, Bob and Betty Bloch and his maternal grandparents, Wallace and Carolyn Hucks.

Riley leaves many close family and friends in his short 17 years. Anyone who spent time with Riley knew the places to find him were a mud hole, a duck hole, or a fishing hole. Always remember Riley will be with you the next time you are there.

A funeral service will be held at 3:30 PM Sunday, March 1, 2015 at Tilly Swamp Baptist Church with Rev. Scott Altman officiating and Mr. Cooper Chavis "His Brother from another Mother" speaking on behalf of the family and friends.
