Robert Moore Taylor, 69, of Myrtle Beach, passed away quietly at his home with his loving wife and his favorite pets by his side on October 26, 2022.

Mr. Taylor was born March 28, 1953, the son of Robert Taylor and Fay 'Nanny' Taylor. He was enlisted in the US Navy from 1970 through 1973. He served as an SN E-3 radio operator on the USS Camden, receiving a National Service Defense Medal and Vietnam Service Medal. After being honorably discharged, Bobby attended the Betty Stevens Cosmetology Institute. He worked for many notable salons and the New York Hair shows. He also traveled the world with Paul Mitchell. Later he opened his own salon, Jordan Marsh Studios in Myrtle Beach, named after his son. Most importantly, Bobby gave his life to Christ attending Beach Church. He had the joy of being baptized in the ocean by his son!

He was preceded in death by his father, Robert Taylor and his mother, Fay 'Nanny' Taylor.

Bobby is survived by his wife, Sandra Esty Taylor; his son, Jordan Marsh Taylor and his wife Samantha; and two grandchildren, Abel and Abba. Bobby is also survived by his five brothers and sisters and their families.

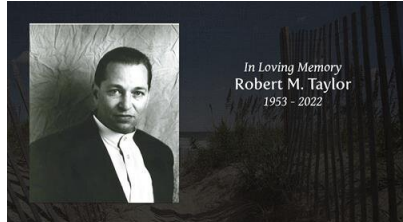
