Conway.....Robert E. "Bob" Jamison, age 84, of Hwy. 319, died Friday, May 5, 2006 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center. Mr. Jamison was born February 23, 1922 in Kosciusko, Mississippi, a son of the late Robert E. Jamison, Sr. and Martha Dodd Jamison. Mr. Jamison was a member of Maple Baptist Church, the Conway Masonic Lodge # 65 A.F.M. and the Omar Temple of the Shrine. He was a member and past president of the Conway Kiwanis Club where he was voted man of the year. Mr. Jamison was president of the Conway Chamber of Commerce in 1976 and received the Field and Herald Man of the Year Award in 1987. He was past president of the National Telephone Cooperative Association and served on the board for 18 years. Mr. Jamison was a World War Two and Korean War Navy Veteran and was a member of the American Legion Post # 111. He retired from Horry Telephone Cooperative as Manager in 1987 after 31 years of service. Surviving are his wife, Aubrey Outlaw Jamison of Conway, three sons, Dr. Robert G. Jamison of Florence, William E. "Billy" Jamison of Conway and Michael F. Jamison and his wife, Tamara of Socastee, two daughters, Audrey Anne Jamison of Florence and Tamria Jamison Strickland and her husband, Roger of Conway, four grandchildren, Bo Jamison, Happy Jamison, Jami Lyn Carter and Ben Collins and one sister, Faye Tolleson of Kosciusko, Mississippi. 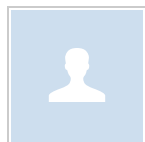
