Robert Earl Fite, age 93 of Quail Creek Village, Conway, SC, died Friday June 25, 2004 at his residence. Born June 1, 1911 in Pennsville, PA, he was a son of the late Robert and Nancy Fite. He was the husband of Leola H. Fite, to whom he was married for 65 years. After graduating from Scottdale High School, Mr. Fite played professional baseball for the Detroit Tigers Organization. He was a partner in Penn Line Service since 1953, until his retirement in 1977, as President & Chairman of the Board. He was a member of the Elks Club, Lions Club, Pleasant Valley Country Club, Ligonier County Club, and was avid fund-raiser for the Boy Scouts of America in Westmoreland County, PA, for which he received many awards. He was a former member of the First Presbyterian Church in Scottdale, PA, where he served as Elder and Sunday School Superintendent, the Covenant Presbyterian Church in Ligonier, PA, and member of the First Presbyterian Church of Myrtle Beach. Surviving in addition to his wife, are three sons R. Dennis Fite and his wife Trish of Cary, NC, Theodore Lynn Fite and his wife Dorothy of Scottdale, PA, James "Jim" Rodney Fite and his wife Mary of Conway, SC; 8 grandchildren Stephanie Lynn Fite, R. Christopher Fite, Rebekah Fite, Jean Fite, Julie Fite Hutchinson, Jodi Lynn Fite, Katie Marie Fite and James Bennett Fite; one sister Ruth Fite Klingensmith of Richmond, VA; and several nieces and nephews.
