Robert Henegar Surfside Beach Robert "Bob" Henegar age 73, died peacefully on Tuesday February 3, 2009 at his home with his loving wife Phyllis by his side, following a long illness. Mr. Henegar joined the U.S. Park Police in 1958. In the 1970's he was a member of the presidential motorcade in Washington. He and his squad escorted Presidents Nixon, Ford and Carter on trips out of the White House. After retiring from the Park Police, he came to Myrtle Beach and joined the Myrtle Beach Police Department and became the Captain of the Uniform Patrol Force until he retired. During his lifetime, Bob influenced many people and was loved and will be missed by all who knew him. Bob was preceded in death by a brother, John "Jack" Henegar of Greenbackville, VA. Surviving in addition to his wife Phyllis, a brother, Douglas "Doug" Henegar and his wife Jo of Hedgesville, WV; sons, Bob Jr. and his friend Sherry of Loris and Jim of Raleigh, NC; three daughters, Janie Dolan of Raleigh, NC, Annie and her husband John Huffman of Graysdale, IL and Leah Lewis of Oriental, NC; a step-son, Tom Baber of Lolo, MT and a step-daughter, Diana and husband Charles Hastings of Broomfield, CO; an aunt, Margaret Suthard of Leesburg, FL; sisters-in-law, Carolyn Henegar of Huntington, MD, and Ellen and husband Leroy Brown of Oceana, WV; a brother-in-law, Raymond and wife Susie Walker of Oceana, WV and many, many friends.
