Captain Robert D. Jones (88) of Myrtle Beach S.C. has passed away peacefully at home amongst family after bravely battling multiple illnesses. Robert, who was most fondly remembered by his family as “Gee” (but also RD, Cap, Bobby, Bomber) was born and raised in Staten Island, NY by parents Daniel and Jean. Bob was a talented athlete in his younger years and excelled in both basketball and baseball during his high school years. After graduating from Curtis HS, the NY (baseball) Giants drafted Bob where he enjoyed playing the sport he loved most. Shortly thereafter he was drafted into the Army and served in the Korean War. Upon his return from serving his country, Mr. Jones joined the NY/NJ Sandy Hook Pilots Association where he forged a long and distinguished career, capped by guiding the Queen Mary II through the NY harbor on its maiden voyage.

Bob is survived by his wife Angela (Mingione) of 66 years and his 5 children, Jean (Steve) DeGaetano, Cookie (Joe) Annaloro, Barbara (Russ) Salerno, Kathy (Kevin) Case and Robert (Gina) Jones Jr. He is also survived by his sister Judy (John) Cascella, in-laws Lucille & George McLendon, Dominick & Patricia Mingione, and Francine Peterson. Bob was predeceased by his parents Daniel and Jean as well as brother Daniel Jr.

Bob was also an avid golfer who passed his passion, talent and knowledge of sports along to his family. He loved nothing more than watching one of his 16 grandchildren or 12 great grandchildren playing sports and could often be seen in the bleachers or under a tree watching a game. Prior to watching

games, he coached Bobby Jr's 1984 team to the Babe Ruth World Series, finishing 4th in the nation.

His love of family was immeasurable. Family gatherings were truly a blessing for the entire family as he lit up the room with his infectious personality and the smile of a mischievous young boy.
