ROBERT THADDEUS JONES, JR. (1941–2026)

Robert “Bob” Thaddeus Jones, Jr., 84, of Murrells Inlet, South Carolina, passed away on Tuesday, May 12, 2026. He was born in Washington, D.C., on July 20, 1941, to Robert T. Jones, Sr., and Myrtle W. Jones.

Bob graduated from Montgomery Blair High School in Silver Spring, Maryland, where he was an AllMetropolitan star football player. He went on to earn an associate degree from Montgomery College and settled in Gaithersburg, Maryland. He enjoyed a long and successful career with Potomac Electric Power Company (Pepco), finishing his career in procurement management.

After retiring from Pepco, Bob and his wife Vicki moved to Murrells Inlet. Their home became a beloved gathering place for children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren visiting the Myrtle Beach area. A gifted cook and gracious host who never met a stranger, Bob took great pleasure in preparing meals and welcoming guests, always making each person feel important. He stayed active in the wider community, driving residents of the Lakes of Litchfield retirement community in Pawleys Island to shopping venues along the Grand Strand — where his humor, hospitality, and warm personality left a lasting impression.

Family members remember “Uncle Bobby” for his love of the outdoors. He spent countless days crabbing, fishing, boating, and waterskiing. He also looked forward to family trips to Deerfield, Virginia, and Florida — journeys that became treasured adventures and the source of many favorite stories.

A true jack of all trades, Bob could fix nearly anything. He handled his own car maintenance and electrical work, painted houses (often alongside his father), and tackled a wide range of home projects. He enjoyed teaching those practical skills and sharing his commonsense wisdom with younger generations. In later years he found joy in painting

his granddaughters’ nails, a small ritual that revealed his playful side and deep love for family.

Bob and Vicki enjoyed riding his cherished Honda Gold Wing. He completed two crosscountry motorcycle trips from South Carolina. He was also an avid downhill skier who took yearly ski trips with family and friends. Together they traveled widely, both across the United States and abroad, visiting destinations as far away as Alaska and Austria.

Bob was a devoted son, brother, husband, father, fatherinlaw, grandfather, great-grandfather and friend, and he will be deeply missed by his family and friends. He was preceded in death by his son, R. Kevin Jones; his sisters, Bette A. Sarvay and Patricia E. Dixon; and his parents, Myrtle W. Jones and Robert T. Jones, Sr.
