Robert D'Ambrosio Pawleys Island Robert "Chip" D'Ambrosio age 68, died Friday, June 5, 2009 at his residence. Mr. D'Ambrosio was born and raised in South Philadelphia, PA, a son of the late Ovid and Marion D'Ambrosio. He attended the LaSalle Prep School and received both undergraduate and law degrees from Villanova University. He was admitted to the bar in Pennsylvania and was a member of American Bar Association. Mr. D'Ambrosio was a veteran of the United States Air Force and the USAF Reserve, retiring as a Colonel in the JAG Corps. He was a Civil Service Attorney for the Military Commissary System in Richmond, VA. He volunteered with the Georgetown Hospital Auxiliary and also with the Pawleys Island Rescue Squad. Mr. D'Ambrosio was a member of Holy Cross Faith Memorial Episcopal Church where he was a choir member. Chip was especially known for his quick wit, entertaining friends and family. This gift was also on display when he performed sketches with the Coastal Chorale.
