Robert "Bob" Weeks age 94 of Socastee, SC, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, December 29, 2020.

Born November 17, 1926, he was the son of the late James Edward Weeks, Sr. and Katherine Shirer Weeks.

Mr. Weeks was a native of Columbia, SC and graduated from Bob Jones University. He was a veteran and served honorably on a hospital ship in the Philippines during WWII as well as in Germany during the Korean war. In 1958 he married Yvonne Weeks and they were happily married for 62 years.

A schoolteacher, Christian camp worker, vice principal of the MB Airforce base school, and cabinet maker were some of his varied occupations. He was the pastor of Calvary Bible Church and the principal of Calvary Christian School for many years. He was a beloved husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather.
