North Myrtle Beach.....Roberta Ward Rust, 97, died Sunday, September 23, 2007 at her home in North Myrtle Beach, SC. Mrs. Rust was born October 29, 1909 in Horry County, the daughter of the late Robert Vance Ward and Katherine Boege Ward. She had lived more than 35 years in Conway, SC before moving to NMB. After graduating from Mitchell College, she continued her education at the University of NC Chapel Hill. For 42 years she was a school teacher and principal in Horry County. Mrs. Rust was a charter member of the Business Professional Women's Association of Conway, a member of the National, State and Horry County Education Associations. She served on the first board of trustees that developed the Horry County Museum. Her other memberships included the Horry County Historical Society and the Fine Arts Club of Conway. Mrs. Rust was a member of King of Glory Lutheran Church of North Myrtle Beach. She was predeceased by her husband, Carl K. Rust and two sisters, Grace W. White and Carrie Lee Ward.
