



Rocco J Cartisano

May 28, 1931 - February 6, 2018

Mr. Rocco J. "Rocky" Cartisano, 86, passed away Tuesday, February 6, 2018 at Embrace Hospice House in Myrtle Beach.

Born May 28, 1931 in Arnold, PA, he was the son of the late Philip Cartisano and the late Mary Catherine "Kate" Schlabig Cartisano. Mr. Cartisano served his country in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict and was a recent recipient of the Quilt of Valor. He was of the Methodist faith and served as a volunteer with the Conway Chamber of Commerce. Rocky graduated from the University of Pittsburgh and studied towards his Masters Degree at the University of Maryland. He enjoyed a long career as a manager with Western Electric and worked as a research associate with Coastal Carolina University. He was predeceased by his loving wife of 61 years, Dorothy Knepshield Cartisano.
