



## Roger Dean Bosse

Roger Dean Bosse passed away on Wednesday, August 2, 2023, at his residence in Murrells Inlet, SC, at the age of 70. Roger was born on December 13, 1952, in Havre de Grace, MD, and was the son of the late Francis Xavier and Virginia Mae (Dumdey) Bosse. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, David Lee Bosse in 2011. Roger is survived by his beloved wife, Mary J. He was proficient in personnel management, operations management, and communications within all areas/levels of an organization.

Roger loved boating and sports, both playing and spectator, and was a devoted fan and season ticket holder of the then Washington Redskins (now Commanders) football team. He was an outstanding pool player, nearly

choosing a professional billiards career over his ultimate love of the food industry.
