Ronald A. Brugge, 88, of Myrtle Beach, SC passed on Wednesday, June 14, 2023, surrounded by his family. Ron was born in Memphis, TN, on August 18, 1934, to Arno and Lucille Brugge, both of whom predeceased him, as well as his sister, Arlene Hunter. He served in the U.S. Army for two years, stationed in Germany. He went on to earn his BS in mechanical engineering from Christian Brothers University in 1962. Ron moved to Martinsville, VA, in 1962 where he began a 34-year career with DuPont, working in Martinsville, Waynesboro, VA and Maitland, Canada, before retiring to Pawleys Island, SC in 1996.
