Loris..... Ronald Layton Shelley, SFC USA(Ret.), age 93, passed away Sunday, June 7, 2026.

Mr. Shelley was born in Conway, a son of the late Roshier Brian Shelley, Sr. and late Minnie Cooper Shelley. He was drafted in 1953 into the US Army on active duty during the Korean War. Mr. Shelley then served in the US Army Reserves for four years from 1956 - 1961. He then re-enlisted in the US Army in 1961 and served active duty from 1961 to 1979 where he served with Honor, Distinction, and Integrity. Mr. Shelley retired in 1979 with 26 ½ years of service, serving two tours of duty in Vietnam as a 11B40 (SFC) Infantry Platoon Sergeant. He was awarded three Bronze Star Medals with V device, the Air Medal, the Combat Infantryman Badge and the Drill Sergeant Identification Badge. He retired from the US Army and then served in the South Carolina National Guard. But the greatest honor and privilege of his life was taking care of his family and his faith in God. The level of love and dedication and commitment to his family and friends are what made this man so very special to all who knew him. He always had a kind word, encouragement, love, and advice for anyone. Mr. Shelley was truly a very special blessing to everyone who knew him. He was a husband, a father, a brother, a son, an uncle, a mentor and the best friend anyone could ever have and was a man of his word. Mr. Shelly was admired by all who knew him and he will be deeply missed.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Shelley was predeceased by his first wife, Doris Johnson Shelley and his second wife, Malaise Field Shelley; six brothers, R. B. Shelley, Jr., Charles Shelley, Don Shelley, Don Shelley, Frierson Shelley, Jackie Shelley, and Buster Shelley; and four sisters, Ruby Columbio, Marie Graham, Jean Long, and Mary Duncan.
