Rosalyn Eldridge Clontz, age 76, loving wife, mother and grandmother, passed away peacefully at home, on Tuesday, June 18, 2019 after a long illness of COPD and Parkinson's Disease.

She was a true Myrtle Beach native, born in a beach house on Ocean Boulevard, to Elbert and "Sonny" Lizette Vereen Eldridge on December 8, 1942.

She is predeceased by her parents, infant daughter, Donna Lane Clontz and son in law Jimmy McKnight, all of Myrtle Beach.
