Roy D. R.D. Pappy Brigham, Jr., of Stacey St., died Saturday, June 26, 2004 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center. Born June 18, 1923 in Johnsonville, SC he was the son of the late Roy D. Brigham, Sr. and Mary L. Thompson Brigham. Mr. Brigham, known to his friends as R.D. or Pappy, was a US Army veteran serving in the Philippines during WWII. He was a resident of Myrtle Beach for 60 years and was most known for his fishing talents and skills. There is a special fishing charted spot in Murrells Inlet named for him; The Brigham Hole, because of the amount of fish that he has caught there. He even touched the lives of many tourists while surf fishing on the beach at 82nd and 46th Ave. North. He and his wife Tina has been instrumental in teaching many family and friends about fishing out of love they have for the sport. Mr. Brigham retired as a driver with 32 years of service from Nu Way Cleaners in Myrtle Beach. He later retired as owner and operator of City Bait and Tackle in Myrtle Beach with over 30 years of service to the community. He will surely be missed by family, friends and anyone that has ever met him. Survivors in addition of his wife of 56 years, Tina Brigham are 3 sons, Roy D.
