Conway...Roy Glenn Ellis, 81, of Myrtle Trace, died peacefully after an illness on January 24, 2012 at the home he shared with his wife Nancy.

He was born in St. Joseph, Missouri, the son of the late Lester and Mabel Null Ellis.

After graduating from high school, he enlisted in the Marine Corp where he served two tours of duty, one at the close of WWII, and the other at the onset of the Korean War, receiving an Honorable Discharge after each tour.

Following 3 years with Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad, he relocated to the Washington DC area where, over a period of 40 years, he worked for Melpar Inc., Atlantic Research Corporation, Computer Sciences Corporation and the National Academy of Sciences.

Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Nancy G. Ellis of Conway, SC; his loving sons Jeffrey William Ellis and Richard Lawrence Ellis, each of Aldie, Virginia; a sister, Anna Jean Palmer of Indianapolis, IN; a brother, Dale Ellis of St. Joseph, MO; a sister in law, Edith Ellis of Eugene OR, and several nieces and nephews. He is predeceased by his brothers, G. Russell Ellis and Millard H. Ellis.

A memorial service with military honors will be held at 1:00 PM on Monday, January 30, 2012 at Christ the Servant Lutheran Church, 2105 Highway 501, Conway SC, 29526 with the Rev. Marion Brazell officiating.
