Georgetown... Roy Rogers, age 83, passed away Monday, March 5, 2012.

Mr. Rogers was born April 20, 1928, in Georgetown, SC a son of the late William Rogers and Lula Miller Rogers. He was a veteran of the US Navy and US Marine Corps. Mr. Rogers was a member of Mt. Tabor Baptist Church where he had served as Deacon. He was a former estate manager and dog trainer. Mr. Rogers was a generous and faithful Christian and a devoted "prayer warrior."
