MYRTLE BEACH..Roy A. Shellenberger, age 82 of Deerfield, died Saturday, September 2, 2006 at National Health Care. Born August 22, 1924 in New Castle, PA, the youngest son of the late Clyde and Laura Linzey Shellenberger. He was a US Navy Veteran, serving 3 years of submarine service. He attended Geneva College and Penn State University in PA. Mr. Shellenberger was a charter member of the Chippawa United Presbyterian Church in Beaver Falls, PA. He also served on the Chippawa School Board. He worked at the Babcock & Wilcox Steel Co. for 40 years and ended his career there as Superintendant of Melting and Blooming. After retiring, he had a second career for 21 years at Surfside Beach Wal-Mart. He served as Secretary for the Electric Metal Workers Guild whose members are electric furnace steelmakers in the United States, Mexico and the United Kingdom. He was a 50 year member of the Masonic Lodge 662 in Beaver Falls. He is a charter member of Trinity Presbyterian Church of Surfside Beach where he served as an Elder. Mr. Shellenberger was pre-deceased by a brother: Dale Shellenberger. Surviving are his wife of 60 years: Helen Huddie Bosworth Shellenberger of Myrtle Beach; one son: Rory B. Shellenberger of Myrtle Beach; one daughter: Kimberly Shellenberger Daily and husband, Lt. Col. Duncan Daily of Cedarville, Ohio; two grandchildren: Colleen Daily and Kyle Daily both of Cedarville, Ohio.; two sisters: Elaine Patterson of Cookeville, TN. and Betty Hollschwandners of Leesburg, Fla.
