



## Sallie Loveland

September 8, 1945 - December 1, 2014

Nichols...Sallie Marie Moore Loveland, age 69, passed away Monday, December 1st, 2014 at her home with her son Scott Loveland and dearest friend Lydia Conway at her side following a long battle with breast cancer.

Ms. Loveland was born in Savannah, GA, the daughter of the late John Pearly Moore and the late Cottie Anderson Moore. She was a graduate of Winthrop University, a member of the Spring Branch Baptist Church, and enjoyed teaching, volunteering, antiquing, cooking and spending time with family and friends. She particularly enjoyed traveling and during her 20's extensively toured the British Isles, Western Europe, Mexico, Russia, India, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand, and Japan. Ms. Loveland worked 28 years for the State of South Carolina, both for the Clemson Extension Service and the Horry County School System. During her tenure with the school system she founded the now well-established Culinary Arts program at the Academy for Technology and Academics in Conway, SC.

Survivors include three sons, Scott Moore Loveland and wife Kristen Loveland of Charleston, Patrick Gray Loveland of Charleston, Christopher Daniel Loveland and wife Jawleh Loveland of Lexington; three grandchildren, Elizabeth Loveland, Madeline Loveland, and Sophia Loveland; and brother Dr. John Luther Moore and Arlene Moore of Camden, SC.

Visitation will be held Friday, December 5, 2014 from 6:00-8:00 PM at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Loris Chapel.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 AM Saturday, December 6, 2014 at Spring Branch Baptist Church with Rev. Michael Vipperman officiating. Burial will follow in the Spring Branch Cemetery.

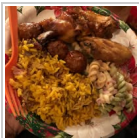
