Mr. Sam Nolan Huggins, 80, husband of Shirley Marie Huggins, died Saturday, October 3, 2015 at Tidelands Community Hospice House.

He was born September 18, 1935 in Horry County. He was the son of the late Rufus James and Fronnie Stroud Huggins. In addition to his parents, was preceded in death by five brothers and five sisters.
