Conway...Samuel Joseph Quarterman, 77, husband of 54 years to the late Edith LuVane Lewis Quarterman, died Saturday, June 18, 2011 at Agape Hospice in Conway.

Mr. Quarterman was born in Brunswick, GA a son of the late Vossey Alexander and Mary Wilson Quarterman. He was a member of Sharon Baptist Church. Served in South Carolina National Guard C. B 118th Infantry 51st Division (Washington Light Infantry) prior to enlisting in the US Air Force during the Korean Era. Retired from the Office of the Supervisor of Shipbuilding, Conversion and Repair, United States Navy, 6th Naval District, Charleston, SC. As Ships Surveyor, Mechanical Systems. Raised to the degree of Master Mason in Walhalla Lodge No. 66 AFM in March of 1955. Charter Member, Past Master and Life member of Olde Charles Towne Lodge No. 405 AFM and Orange-Charles Towne Lodge No. 14 AFM. Past President of the Charleston Air Force Base (Now Charleston Area) Square and Compass Club. Thirty Second Degree Scottish Rite Mason. Member of The National Association of Retired Federal Employees, The American Legion, The Forty and Eight, The Disabled American Veterans and an associate member of The Blind Veterans Association. Mr. Quarterman was a loving and devoted father, grandfather and great grandfather.

grandchildren, Tiffany Edwards of Aynor, Ross Edwards, Jr. and Derrick Edwards both of Conway. Two great grandchildren Trevor Edwards and Cooper Boyd both of Aynor, SC.
