April 27, 1915 - January 18, 2013

Rev. Frank Sanders, 97, died Friday, January 18, 2013 at Conway Manor Nursing Home after a brief illness.

Rev. Sanders was born in Conway, a son of the late George Ephriam Sanders and the late Eliza Jane Cannon Sanders Paul. He is also predeceased by his stepfather, Sam Moses Paul.

He retired from the CSX Railroad after 34 years of service. Rev. Sanders enjoyed farming and pastored at many area churches in the Lower Pee Dee region for 60 years. He was a longtime member of the Freewill Baptist of the Pentecostal Faith Conference since 1955. At his death he was a member of Conway Freewill Baptist Church.

Rev. Sanders was predeceased by his wife of 73 years, Mitchell C. Sanders; six brothers, Clarence (Kit) Sanders, Thomas Ollie Sanders, Kenneth Blease Sanders, Bethel Woodrow Sanders, George O'Neil Sanders, and Edgar Norman Cannon; one sister, Nettie May Sanders.
