Sara Dusenbury Clardy, age 88, passed away Friday, July 17, 2015 at her residence.

Mrs. Clardy was born in Columbus County, NC, a daughter of the late Claude Bethea and Mildred McCoy Dusenbury.

She was a 1945 graduate of Conway High School and worked at the former Myrtle Beach Air Force Base until 1947 and then at AVX Corporation until 1950 when she married the Rev. Wallace D. Clardy, Sr. who passed away in 2000. Mrs. Clardy was of the Baptist faith and supported her husband and son in their ministries. She lived her life each day as a reminder to all of us to keep our eye on the Cross. Mrs. Clardy was a devoted wife, mother, and grandmother.
