Columbia, SC...Sarah Holt Hendrick, age 87, wife of the late Jimmy Hendrick died Saturday, June 2, 2012 in Columbia.

Mrs. Hendrick was born in Conway, SC, a daughter of the late John and Sue Holt. She was a stay at home mother whose joy and delight were her family. She married Jimmy Hendrick in 1946 and they were married for 64 years. Together they enjoyed life and the raising of their two children. They were charter members of Trinity United Methodist Church, where she was a member of several missionary circles and the Ladies Fellowship Class. Mrs. Hendrick was also a member of the Gardenia Garden Club and the order of the Eastern Star.
