SeanMichael was a 2013 graduate of Myrtle Beach High School where he played baseball and football and was a member of the 2011 3A State Championship Football Team. He served as defensive captain of the football team in 2012 and 2013. SeanMichael attended Limestone College on an academic/athletic scholarship where he played football and was currently attending classes at Horry Georgetown Technical College. He was employed by Captain George's Seafood Restaurant and was an active member of St. Philip Lutheran Church. SeanMichael loved his family and community and enjoyed his high school years at MBHS.
