Sharon Ann (DeLuke) Musiol went home to be with the Lord on August 12, 2024 after a difficult battle with lung cancer. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother, who will be dearly missed by all those who crossed paths with her.

Sharon was born on May 16, 1943 and grew up in Niagara Falls, New York along with her three siblings. She was a graduate of LaSalle Senior High School and began an adventurous life in 1962 when she earned her wings as an American Airlines stewardess in Fort Worth, Texas. Her first assignment was to the airline's AstroJets fleet flying out of New York City. While working in this role, she met her future husband, Joe, and they married in June of 1966 after his graduation from the United States Military Academy. They remained dedicated to each other for the next 58 years.
