Sharon Nobles Odom, 69, went home to be with the Lord on Monday, October 19, 2020.

Sharon was born in San Antonio, TX, a daughter of the late Rufus Virgil and Marlese Boyd Nobles. Sharon was a graduate of Hillcrest High School Class of 1971 of Sumter, SC. She was also a graduate of Lee University Class of 1975 of Cleveland, TN. Sharon was a devoted member of Conway Church of God where she served as a Greeter and Choir member. While in Sumter, SC she attended Sumter Church of God where she served as a Sunday School Teacher, Youth Minister, Christian Television Hostess for Lifeline Ministry and Gospel singer.
