“ I am the cousin that is closest in age to Sherry. My brother Terry is closest in age to our cousin Eddy. Just now learning of Sherry's passing has come with great and unexpected grief, bringing back a flood of forgotten memories of my earliest youth. You see, when Sherry and I were young and my parents were still married and the matriarch of our family known as grandma Smith was still alive, both my parents and grandma Smith would have extended family get to gethers. Those BBQs and outdoor parties were the highlights of my youth. Me and Terry could not wait to see Eddy and Sherry, as they were always known. Why Eddy was always first in the cousins name reference I have no idea. Maybe because, as I remember Eddy was a firecracker and his name was often called or yelled by our loud and dominating grandma Smith the most. To us they were always "Eddy and Sherry". Sherry was close to my age but a tiny bit older, so I always followed her around and got into whatever she was up to. Even at an early age we knew we had a lot in common. As it turns out our future life's experiences are similar as well. I am also an Army vet and spent much of my life training servers and bartenders. Although I hung around Sherry the most, it was firecracker Eddy who was the main part of one of the scariest experiences of my young life. At one of our BBQs on our property out in the woods, Eddy and I, with Eddie's encouragement, ventured out in the woods, way beyond the point that I was allowed or ever traveled before or since. All the sudden we found ourselves surrounded by a pack of wild dogs. I was so scared I froze in place. Firecracker Eddy instantly bolted, leaving me alone, stranded and surrounded. I remember being so mad at him and wondering at the moment where Sherry was to save me. Just about the time the dogs started closing in on me, out of the blue my father showed up and shot a gun in the air and scared off all the dogs. Turned out Eddy didn't leave me stranded he went to get reinforcements. I was so grateful. Sherry was a big part of my earliest years and I loved her very much. I looked forward to seeing her the most at functions even more than my own half sister, who also lived away. I never forgot her and Eddy. Unfortunately after my parents divorce and soon after, the death of grandma Smith happened. Our family

*splintered onto a million pieces. Tensions occurring with all of the adults in our families brought a sudden end to our young blissful family gatherings. I never saw Sherry and Eddy again. I never forgot Sherry and her brother and would often think of her fondly and often wondered how she was doing in life. Because I moved the Florida and turned out to be the wildest of all the children myself I lost track of most people in the family. This coupled with my disdain for social media and a late in life simplification of my own life has left me out of the loop so to speak in family life. So, I am the last to find out about such tragedies as the passing of my favorite childhood cousin Sherry. I wished now that I would have had the presence of mind to reconnect, kept in touch and had the chance to talk to Sherry again. I'll bet she was as much of a hoot to know in her later life as I remember her being when we were close cousins and friends. I still love you Sherry and will always miss you for the rest of my life.
