




Shirley Christina Smiling







“ The last time we saw you all (Christine included) put me in mind of every time I visited Christine's house when I was growing up in Fayetteville and even before Fayetteville when I lived in Baltimore and would come down with my family to visit relatives in North Carolina. "Welcomed" is not a word that can aptly describe the warmth with which I was received, with or without my mom and dad and siblings. Even though she was my first cousin, Christine seemed more like an older sister to me and always made me feel like one of her own. I was just as at home at her house as I was in the home of my own parents. Albert was no different. As with my own mom and dad and siblings, so with Christine and Albert, Kim, Paula, Mark, and Michael. I did not go to their house unless I also brought with me two big appetites: one for mouth-watering home-cooked food and the other for a well-spring of lively conversation. But even after I had eaten too much and stayed far too long and into the night, I still could not easily leave. For I would always be pressed to "stay a while longer and get another piece of cake or pie." Or, it would be too late for me to go, and I would be invited to "just spend the night and get up and leave tomorrow after breakfast." Late at night and, sometimes, even the next day, I would eventually manage to leave Christine's house. But the truth is there was no leaving Christine. Whether it was some pearl of wisdom imparted to you as an adolescent in Sunday School at the Lakedale Church of God in Fayetteville; or her anointed voice echoing in your ears over all the years from some solo she sang at church; or the extra-big piece of dessert she'd give you when she saw that you were having a down day while you were going through the cafeteria line at South View Senior High; or the spirited biblical exchange she could enter into with a complete stranger while waiting to visit my father after his open-heart surgery at Duke; or just her joy and infectious smile and laughter, Christine's extraverted presence pervaded every room she occupied and buoyed the spirits of everyone she encountered. Some part of this wonderful trait she passed to all of her children, who carry her with and in themselves such that we who have always known them little wonder why so many find themselves inexplicably drawn to the Smiling family. You

are, each of you, a genuine, generous, engaged, deeply-rooted, and loving person. And long long after I have found myself physically parted from you all, I also find that my spirit never can leave you. The attachment runs too deep. I know that Christine's attachment to each of you is eternal and that she will always be with and in each of you in a way that transcends words. The same doubtless applies to you, Aunt Carr, and to all of Christine's siblings, as to my mom and dad, who thought of Christine as one of their own. Even so, my heart goes out to you who, in the space of a very few years, have lost Darryl, Lib, and now Christine. And I do not forget (nor is God unmindful) that you, Mark and Michael, have lost two mothers and that you, Albert, have lost two wives. And that all of these losses of loved ones were quite unexpected. Nevertheless, God has each of you--your times and purposes--in the palm of His hand. As sure as the sun will rise tomorrow, He has and is holding each one of you for His good purposes. You are ever in our thoughts and will preoccupy our prayers in the coming days. 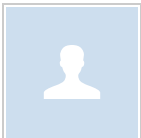

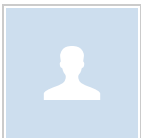

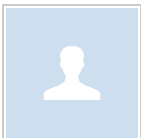
