Sam Petroff, age 79 died Saturday, April 15, 2017 at Tideland's Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Born in Marshall, MI she was the daughter of the late Carl and Jenny Myers. Sam was an avid golfer, gardener, and sports enthusiast who loved the Detroit Lions, Detroit Tigers and Michigan Wolverines. She was an active member of St. Michaels in Murrells Inlet, SC and St. Marys Catholic Churches in Marshall, MI. She was also the first female court bailiff in the state of Michigan. Sam is preceded in death by her husband Ted Petroff.
