Conway-..Soccorso Rizzolino, age 76, of Janette Street died Monday, June 7, 2010 at his residence. Mr. Rizzolino, called Sam or Sammy was born July 19, 1933 in Castel Di Lucio, Providence of Messina, Sicily, Italy to Giuseppe Rizzolino and Maria Lutrie Rizzolino. He attended school in Sicily until Germany invaded and occupied the Island. Mr. Rizzolino married and came to America in 1961. He attended night school and became a United States Citizen. Mr. Rizzolino was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Antonino "Nino" Rizzolino. Upon arriving in the United States, Sammy , while working factory jobs, started a lawn care business with one lawn mower and the family station wagon. This small business grew into what is today Palmer Nursery, Easton, PA, located on 14 acres with 25 employees. Sam was a member of Christ the Servant Lutheran Church. For many years he was a loyal Lion in the Wilsonboro Lions Club. After retiring and moving to SC, he was an active member of the Conway Lions Club.
