Little River...Stella Mae McLamb, age 97, died Monday, September 24, 2012 at her residence.

Mrs. McLamb was born February 22, 1915 in Little River, SC., a daughter of the late Lorenzo Dow and Olivia Bellamy. She was the widow of Ellis Layton McLamb. A devoted and loving mother, grandmother and great grandmother she was predeceased by her daughter, Pollie O.
