Stephanie Ann (Bishop) Banjak, aged 44, of Ocean Isle Beach, NC, passed away on January 3, 2025 at Life Care Hospice in Bolivia, NC. She was a beloved mother, wife, daughter, sister, and friend who will be deeply missed by all who knew her. She was a survivor of childhood leukemia, a Make-A-Wish recipient and participated in The Relay for Life events along the Grand Strand. She graduated from Socastee High School in 1998. She immediately began working at Belin Child Development Center in the toddler room. In 2007, She married her husband, Andrew Banjak and moved to Ocean Isle, NC. She worked at Lowes Foods as a Scan Analyst for the last 17 years. Throughout her career, she was known for her hard work, dedication, and passion for helping others. In her free time she enjoyed collecting knick-knacks, watching Patriots football, taking Jacob on trips with her friend Jessica Inman and camping with family.
