Stephen Bryan Mott, age 30, of Autry Ave., died Saturday, February 17th, 2007 at The Medical University of South Carolina following an illness. Mr. Mott was born in Loris, SC, a son of Timothy Wayne and Glenda Hodges Mott. He was a 1994 graduate of Green-Sea Floyds High School and a 1996 graduate of Horry-Georgetown Technical College.
