December 12, 1945 - June 28, 2012

Steve Kronski age 66, formerly of Ogdensburg, NJ, died Thursday, June 28, 2012 at Tidelands Community Hospice House.

Born in Jersey City, NJ, he was a son of the late Stephen E. and Anna Kronski. Steve was president of the Men's Club at The Tradition in Pawleys Island, SC. He coached baseball for many years and was president of The Ogdensburg Recreation Association, and Board of Health and served on the school board. He was preceded in death by a granddaughter Rhiannon.

Survivors include his wife, Elaine Kronski of The Tradition; three sons, Stephen E. Kronski of Hamburg, NJ, Paul John Kronski of Summerville, SC and Brian Joseph Kronski of Murrells Inlet; six grandchildren, Patrick, Damion, Pauly, Tanner, Joseph and Mia; and a brother, Joseph Kronski of Ocean Isle, NC.
