Mr. Steven J. Hartle, 51, from Lusby, MD, passed away Friday, January 6, 2017 at his parents' home in Conway, SC.

He is survived by his loving sons, Joe, Daniel, Benjamin, and Noah; his sister, Karen Wassum; his brothers, Joe, David, Mike, and Mark; and his parents, Joe and Norma Hartle.
